The Additional Act and the Interpretative Declaration have been accepted and ratified by all these States except Great Britain, which has accepted only the Additional Act, and Norway and Sweden, which have accepted only the Interpretative Declaration. Acceptance of these Acts on the part of the Union States which have hitherto rejected them, or of States which shall hereafter enter the Union, should be made in the form prescribed by Art. 18 of the Convention.
